Dear Families,

We are aware there are some issues with regard to congestion in the Sixth Form Car Park at pick up time after school. Having observed the situation yesterday we need to put in place an approach that will ensure the safety of our students when meeting parents/carers or catching their bus after the end of the academy day.

As you may have seen, barriers have been set up to ensure all traffic flows clockwise around the car park. This is a temporary measure to ensure the construction site can operate effectively during the demolition phase of the High Weald new build. Over the past few days cars have been parking around the outside of the car park which has blocked in other cars and prohibited the movement of buses.

The temporary barriers are going to be present from now until early Spring so we need to ensure that a system is in place and followed by everyone to minimise any disruption and most importantly ensures the safety of our students.

We therefore ask that when picking up your son/daughter you park in a designated bay. Please do not park around the edge of the car park as this blocks movement of other vehicles. We will have a member of our site team directing traffic each day and ensuring the buses park to the left and as far along as possible to ensure there is sufficient space for cars to pass and exit the car park.

We appreciate it can be frustrating to have to wait an extended period of time but we ask for your patience and support during this exceptional time.

Let's all work together to ensure our students remain safe.
